### **1. His Raising In Faith**

**His parents were people of faith –**

*“By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.”*

**Hebrews 11:23**

### **2. His Refusal by Faith –**

*“By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;”* Hebrews 11:24-25

**He refused the social standing of the world**

### **3. His Reproach Because Of His Faith –**

*“Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.”* Hebrews 11:26

### **4. His Rejection Sustained By His Faith –**

*“By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.”* Hebrews 11:27

### **5. His Realization Was The Result Of His Faith –**

*“By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.”* Hebrews 11:29
