

THE GREATEST INVITATION EVER GIVEN MATT. 11:28-30

Intro: There are two types of rest – Verses 28-29. There is the rest that comes with.

1. Salvation – verse 28

His salvation frees us from

1. The bondage of the Law – Gal. 5:1
2. The burdens of the legalist – Matt. 23:4 Acts 15:10-11

2. Surrender – verse 29

When our life is surrendered to the yoke of the Saviour we will enjoy

1. A tranquility that is real – Verse 29
2. A togetherness that is rewarding – Verses 29-30

THE GREATEST INVITATION EVER GIVEN (NOTICE)

1. The simplicity of this invitation - Verse 28a “Come unto me “

1. What this invitation excludes – Gal.2:16, Titus 3:5

2. Who this invitation exalts – Rev. 1:5, 5:9

2. The scope of this invitation – Verse 28:b

All ye that labor and are heavy laden “

Notice that this invitation

1. Is consistent with other scriptural declarations – Rom. 10:12-13, Rev. 22:17
2. Does concur with our Saviours death – 1st. Tim. 2:6, Heb.2:9

3. The sufficiency of the invitation – Verse 28c

I will give you rest

In the sufficiency of the invitation I see

1. Help for our load – 1st. Peter 5:7
2. Hope from our Lord – Matt. 11:28-29 (I will) Verse 28, (You shall) verse 20
